

# Davenham JFC Team Kit Policy

## Players


- No orders placed for new kit until all registration forms and, at least, deposits received.
  - Sponsorship to be obtained for a minimum of £500, which typically funds only 40-50% of the cost – the club will cover the remaining cost.
  - Standard kit for each player consists of home playing shirt, home playing shorts, home playing socks (old stock whilst it lasts) and ¼ zip training top.
  - Additional kit, such as change shirt, rain jackets etc. must be fully funded by the team on top of the minimum £500 sponsorship either by additional sponsorship, parent contribution, fund raising etc.
  - Kit is to be used for at least two full seasons before being replaced.
  - ¼ zip training top should have squad number not initials printed (this is so that if a player leaves there is a complete set of kit that can be collected back in and reused).
  - All orders to be placed through the club “Kit Manager” using the kit order for on the DJFC website.
- 
- If a player leaves the kit bundle should be collected back and used for any new players.
  - If new players join and no kit can be reused, then the club will cover the cost of its purchase mid-refresh cycle once the player is registered and at least a deposit paid.
  - In exceptional circumstances a player may grow out of their kit mid-cycle (although kit should be sized to last at least two seasons) in which case the club will cover the cost of a replacement. HOWEVER, the club reserves the right to ask for a contribution from the team if a good number of the squad require replacement kit mid-cycle.
- 
- If a player loses their kit they, or their parents, must cover the cost of replacement.

## Coaches

- No orders placed for new kit until all a coach has completed a valid DBS check and has passed the FA Safeguarding course (as a minimum) plus all registration forms and, at least, deposits received for the squad.
- The club will cover the cost.
- Standard kit for coach consists of training shirt and ¼ zip training top.
- All orders to be placed through the club “Kit Manager”.
- Kit is to be used for at least four full seasons before being replaced.
- Additional kit can be bought directly from Buccaneer at the coaches own cost, ordering directly.

UNIVERSAL FOOTBALL & SPORTS SHIRT (T-SHIRT) – REF: CPL

**FABRIC & FIT**

- Both **STANDARD** and **VALUE FIT** use the exact same production patterns – CPL.
- They are just manufactured with different fabric types.
- VALUE FIT** is manufactured with the entry level waffle fabric 130 gsm in weight it has an eyelet appearance in an airtex style, often preferred in warmer conditions due to increased fabric breathability.
- STANDARD FIT** is manufactured with a premium 130 gsm polyester, silky smooth to the touch.
- All shirts have fully sublimated ribbed collar and cuff material.

**SHIRT OPTIONS**


- Both **VALUE FIT** and **STANDARD FIT** are available in round / O neck, V neck, short and long sleeve options.
- Long Sleeve Goal Keeper shirts are available in both round neck and V neck options and are available with padded sleeves on request.
- Additional neck and shirt detail variations may be available on request.

**SIZING TOLERANCE**

- Each item is individually manufactured and customised with a measurement tolerance of 5% plus or minus.

**SIZING**

- The CPL production pattern is a **regular to slim fit** and it is recommended that the customer pays special attention to the sizing chart and or requests the use of a BSW Sizing Set; it is not uncommon for customers to "upsized" from their normal chosen shirt size for this garment.
- Once a bespoke customised product has been ordered and produced there can be no recourse for an incorrectly ordered size; if you are uncertain ask for a BSW sizing sample set – full sets available to take away upon deposit receipt.
- The Sizing Matrix in this guide provides two measurements against the stipulated size; these measurements are the physical dimensions of the garment and fabric utilised, the height from collar to tail hem and the width from armpit to armpit.
- The dimension armpit to armpit is considered to be the width of the garment and the actual chest size of the fabric used in the garment; BSW have then also recommended a universal chest size appropriate for the fit of this garment, however it is the customer's choice whether they have a preference for a tight or loose fitting garment and they should adjust and order according to their preference.

# Kit Design

## Home Kit

**Note:** team sponsor will replace that shown and team can select its own charity for the back of the shorts (so long as the charity agrees we can use).





Socks = black

## Change/Training Kit:

**Note:** The outfield Change shirt (royal blue with amber collar & cuffs) has been designed to work with the home shorts (black) and home socks (black) in order to provide a more affordable Change kit. (It is more affordable as Change shorts & socks do not need to be purchased).

As Change kit is funded 100% by each team (with no contribution from the club) teams can choose to purchase Change shorts & socks if they so wish.

Goalkeepers can use home shirt if the goalkeepers shirt clashes with the oppositions outfield shirt kit.

**Note:** team sponsor will replace that shown and team can select its own charity for the back of the shorts (so long as the charity agrees we can use).





Socks = royal blue

### Coaches Training Shirt:

**Note:** this cannot be used as playing kit (as black shirts are specifically not allowed as they clash with the referee) but could be used as a training top for players if self-funded.



## Additional Equipment

As well as home playing kit and training tops the club also provides equipment including:

- Training balls.
- Match balls.
- Goals / Nets (if required – dependant on training and match day venues).
- First Aid kit.
- Cones.
- Bibs.
- Pump (to inflate balls).
- Whistle.
- Bag (to keep the above in).
- Trophies - one per player plus up to 4 specials per season.

**Note:** requests for other equipment will be considered & sanctioned at the clubs discretion.

## Exclusive kit & clothing agreement with Buccaneer

DJFC have an exclusive agreement with Buccaneer to provide DJFC branded kit & clothing.

Therefore, all kit & clothing purchased centrally by the club is purchased from Buccaneer. (Home kit, training tops, coaches kit).

To ensure a consistent brand identity all Change kit must be purchase from Buccaneer.

If individual teams wish to purchase additional kit & clothing (for example, coats, rain jackets, track pants, hats etc.) using their own money the club encourages them to purchase this from Buccaneer. Buccaneer have a DJFC club shop on their website and add to this range all the time. Teams should contact Buccaneer directly to discuss their requirement and purchase additional kit directly from Buccaneer.

If individual teams wish to purchase kit & clothing from another supplier (not Buccaneer) the club kindly asks that this is not DJFC branded.
